Three pull-out, drop-down drawers make spices easy to find and reach. Spice bottles are stored horizontally in the drawers with the labels clearly visible. To use, simply slide the drawer out until it's fully extended, then lower the drawer to resting position, where it's easy to identify and retrieve store-bought spices.

The SpiceStack requires no assembly. Four non-skid pads on the bottom of the unit hold it securely in place inside the cabinet. The attractively designed unit, which measures 11 inches wide, 10 3/4 inches deep and 8 inches tall, comes in white to complement any kitchen décor. It holds up to 27 full-size or 54 half-size round spice bottles, or any combination of the two size bottles. Spices can be stored in the drawers alphabetically, by frequency of use, or by type of cooking.
